Head Lice have adapted to resist the effects of pesticides and poisons that used to kill them.

De-Bug

Up to 40 % of American Lice survive pesticide treatments. Lice that survive one pesticide will likely survive others.

De-Bug

What we need are new treatment methods.

De-Bug

Over-the-counter insecticides have proven effective in only 28% head lice tested.

De-Bug

There are American Head Lice that are not susceptible to the most frequently used pesticides. If you have permethrin resistant lice, try something else.

De-Bug

Pesticides only kill 20% of the lice eggs (nits). Up to 80% survive.
